		In light of this, we humbly request you to consider revising Criterion No. 2 to allow participation from firms with relevant private sector experience as well, or to consider private sector project credentials on a case-to-case basis. This would help encourage wider participation from capable and experienced organizations and enhance competition for the benefit of the Commission.

Robmahe Private Limited	Though our organisation does not currently hold prior experience in executing similar projects for government bodies, we humbly wish to bring to your kind attention that the nature of the proposed software is innovative and novel or previously unexplored within the government sector. As such, the lack of previous government-specific experience should not be seen as a limitation but rather as a reflection of the unique and emerging nature of this technology.
